A message from Andrew Fleming, Chief Winemaker

With the 2023 vintage being all but a distant memory, we have been busy assessing the quality of the harvest as well as preparing a number of wines for bottling. Despite the unseasonably wet spring which posed many challenges in the vineyards, the quality of the wines made looks extremely promising. A late ripening period during what turned out to be another mild summer led to the gradual ripening of flavours combined with excellent natural acidity retention. It was our first experience with the recently purchased Beenak Vineyard located in one of the coolest parts of the Yarra – the signs here are very promising. Our expectation is to have a solid range of Single Vineyard and Reserve options ready for release in Spring 2024.

Our new Spring release offers an array of new releases from the 2023 and 2022 vintages – both relatively small vintages, but of excellent quality. In addition, we have included a selection of Trophy and Gold medal winning wines from previous seasons for your enjoyment.

New white wines in the selection are the 2023 Sauvignon Blanc and the 2022 Deer Farm Vineyard Chardonnay – both excellent expressions of cool harvests with vibrancy of varietal character, fine acidity and length of flavour. The new releases complement the 2022 Chardonnay, the 2017 Blanc de Blancs Sparkling (Trophy for Best Sparkling Yarra Valley Wine Show 2022), the 2017 Pinot/Chardonnay Sparkling (Gold Royal Queensland Wine Show 2023) and the 2021 Reserve Chardonnay (Gold Yarra Valley Wine Show 2022).

The red wine selection offers an array of new release Single Vineyard Pinots, each offering an insight into their locales. The 2022 Deer Farm Vineyard Pinot Noir is a worthy follow on from the stellar '21 - again plush, brimming with raspberries and oozing complexity. The counterpoints are the 2022 Esplanade and Reserve Pinot, both slightly warmer sites offering structure, age-worthiness, and dark cherry notes. Included in the pack is the 2021 Deer Farm Pinot, a great opportunity for comparison with the '22 and the 2022 Reserve Shiraz, an excellent cool climate expression of the variety.

Please enjoy the new release packs from our Spring collection. We're grateful to have you on board as members of our Amphitheatre Club, so from the entire team at Coldstream Hills, I wish you an enjoyable six months ahead and trust you'll appreciate the contents of your parcel.



Coldstream Hills Deer Farm Pinot Noir 2022

A wonderful follow-on from the award winning 2021 vintage.

Medium-bodied in style, with great texture and a silky tannin finish. Vibrant raspberry, muddled strawberry and sour cherry characters are beautifully enhanced with mineral graphite, finely tuned French oak and whole bunch spice. Great length and structure from an outstanding vintage.

Pair with a Charcuterie board showcasing camembert cheese, olives and pate.

Coldstream Hills The Esplanade Pinot Noir 2022

An elegant single-site expression.

Plush and inviting with an array of dark cherry and strawberry characters interwoven with spice, seamless French oak, and earthiness. Characteristically savoury and rustic with finely grained tannins, the mild season offered a more elegant expression of this single site.

Pair with grilled salmon alongside a fresh spring salad.

Coldstream Hills Reserve Pinot Noir 2022

Powerful and vibrant, with great cellaring potential.

Medium bodied and savoury with flesh, texture, and a fine chalky tannin finish. Vibrant characters of sour cherry and plum are complemented by hints of mineral graphite, French oak, and whole bunch spice. Powerful and with great length, this Reserve will age beautifully in the Cellar.

Pair with a seared duck breast accompanied with warm spring vegetables.

Coldstream Hills Reserve Shiraz 2022

A new vintage return of the Reserve Shiraz after a hiatus.

This wine is a beautiful example of cool climate Shiraz. Dark cherry, violets, rose petal and five spice are at the fore. Plush, textural and juicy, with characteristic soft chalky tannins.

Pair with red meat dishes or eggplant lasagne.

Coldstream Hills Yarra Valley Pinot Noir 2022

Plush, pure and a true reflection of the Yarra Valley.

This new release vintage contains notes of vibrant sour cherry, raspberry and blue fruits which are beautifully enhanced with hints of mineral graphite, subtle French oak and spice. This a wonderful follow-on from the highly regarded 2021 vintage.

Pair with Asian dishes, game and fresh tuna.

Coldstream Hills Deer Farm Pinot Noir 2021

A superb Pinot Noir vintage in the Yarra.

Brimming with raspberries, strawberries and spice, this wine jumps right out of the glass. Graphite-like slate, French oak and whole bunch stalk add layers of interest. Harmonious, ethereal and with great length of flavour.

Coldstream Hills Yarra Valley Sauvignon Blanc 2023

A vibrant new vintage release perfect for warmer weather ahead.

Cooler seasons always favour the variety with punchy fresh aromas of passionfruit, nettle and gooseberry. Sourced from our Upper Yarra Vineyards, the wine was tank fermented with a small portion matured in French oak.

Lively and pure, a great summer drink.

Pair with seafood fettuccine or crab linguine with fresh herbs.

Coldstream Hills Deer Farm Chardonnay 2022

An excellent Chardonnay vintage in the Yarra.

Fragrant lemon barley and blossom with white flowers and mineral slate. Subtle nougat and creaminess are present with underlying French oak and spice.

Pair with a succulent roast chicken in a lemon marinade with herb roasted potatoes.

Coldstream Hills Yarra Valley Pinot Noir Chardonnay 2017

A beautiful sparkling wine from the Deer Farm Vineyard.

Fine bead with classic Chardonnay citrus line, Pinot perfume and length of flavour. Attractive secondary notes of biscuit and fresh pastry add complexity and style. A true aperitif style.

Perfect as an aperitif and with canapes.

Alcohol 12% Peak Drinking Now to 2028



Coldstream Hills Yarra Valley Chardonnay 2022

A lower yielding vintage, but very generous in flavour.

Vibrant, complex, and layered, this wine is a go-to for Yarra Valley Chardonnay. Lemon curd notes, subtle French oak and beautifully balanced acidity.

Pair with creamy pasta dishes and fresh seafood.

Coldstream Hills Reserve Chardonnay 2020

An outstanding powerful Chardonnay.

Made from a variety of clones, vines planted 1985–1994. Barrel fermented, 9 months in barrique and puncheons (47% new). Aromas of ripe stone-fruits, cumquat, mandarin peel, ginger and grilled nuts lead onto the palate which has real drive and density. Nutty and gently honed, the acidity is already perfectly integrated into the wine.

Coldstream Hills Blanc De Blancs 2017

A classic aperitif style from the Deer Farm Vineyard.

Very fine and restrained with beautifully balanced acidity and length of flavour. Lemon curd/pastry notes are underpinned by subtle yeast autolysis notes, fresh toast, mineral flint, and dosage sweetness. An outstanding year for Upper Yarra sparkling wine.
