Vintage conditions: A cool start to the growing season was overshadowed by a warm and humid late Spring. Dry conditions prevailed throughout the summer months with gloriously warm days and cool nights. A relatively early start to the season, which was fortunately tempered by an even period of sugar and flavour development..

Maturation

Eleven months in French oak – thirty four percent new with the remainder in seasoned French oak barriques.

Colour

Vibrant cherry/crimson with purple hue.

Bouquet

Complex and brooding, with an array of muddled strawberry, cranberry and raspberry fruit characters. Graphite-like mineral notes, spice, and subtle French oak further enhance the wine's aroma.

Palate

Medium-bodied in style with great texture, plushness and length of flavour. Raspberry, muddled strawberry and blueberry characters are underpinned by seamless French oak and graphite-like mineral spice. Complex and layered, the palate is complete with a powdery chalk tannin finish.
